

Call for Papers

25th World Congress of Philosophy

Rome August 1-8, 2024

Application deadline: November 10, 2023

In August 2024, the 25th World Congress of Philosophy will be held in Rome under the theme “Philosophy across Boundaries.”

The 65th of the 89 sections of the Congress is dedicated to the “Philosophy of Information and Digital Culture”. Sybille Krämer – together with two international colleagues – is chair of this section. For this section, contributions (in German or English) of a maximum length of 1800 words together with an abstract of max. 200 words and up to five alphabetically ordered keywords, can now be submitted. Contributions that contain a clear thesis as well as being formally correct have a good chance of being accepted.

Papers in the diverse spectrum of issues and phenomena related to digitality (e.g., from epistemological, anthropological, cultural philosophical, aesthetic, and ethical perspectives) are welcome.
